

Wingate University MBA Program Finance Concentration

I. Overview: This concentration will focus on providing a breadth of financial management expertise including corporate finance and financial decision-making from a corporate perspective, the financial system including financial markets and the role of financial institutions and intermediaries, and investment analysis and portfolio management.

II. Finance Concentration Courses:

1) BUS 640 – Corporate Finance (3 credits)

Overview: This course will focus on financial decision-making from the perspective of the corporation. Topics will include the cost of raising capital, capital structure and investment decisions, venture capital, valuation of closely-held or private corporations, merger valuation, and option analysis.

Prerequisites: Financial Mgt (BUS 623)

2) BUS 641 – Financial Markets & Institutions (3 credits)

Overview: This course will analyze the overall financial marketplace including money, bond, stock, mortgage, and foreign exchange markets, as well as the participants in the financial system, including financial institutions and intermediaries. The course will also focus on the macro economy, including monetary policy and the role of the Federal Reserve Bank.

Prerequisites: Financial Mgt (BUS 623)

III. Concentration Sequence: Upon completion of the prerequisite core course noted above, BUS 640 and BUS 641 may be taken in either order. Including the core course BUS 623, this represents nine credits in total financial management course content.
