The Gate

A brick arch that serves as an entryway to the academic quadrangle, the Gate sends a message of welcome to students who enter through it at the beginning of their time at Wingate and march out in the opposite direction on their graduation day. It's a reminder that a Wingate education can be a gateway to a life of service and success.



The Old Well Spring

This brick monument, with its golden dome, stands in the center of campus at the site of a fresh-water spring that attracted Wingate's founders to this location in 1896. Its four bowls symbolize Wingate's growth from a grade school to a junior college, then a college and now a university. It's also a symbol of how Wingate serves as a wellspring of knowledge and inspiration for students.

We welcome more than 1,100 first-year students to campus in August 2017 — our largest incoming class ever.

With so many new faces, there's likely to be a few growing pains — so we've undertaken several initiatives to enhance the student experience. Among them are the following, which will be completed when school starts or soon after:

- The addition of 16 new faculty members
- A new Starbucks in the Dickson-Palmer Center
- A pop-up snack stand in the Neu Building
- Meal-swipe option at Subway (Levine College of Health Sciences)
- The purchase and renovation of the Days Inn in Monroe, renamed "Hilltop Hall"
- Improvements to campus Wi-Fi

Additionally, we plan to build one new residence hall each year for the next five years, the first to open next fall (2018).

These enhancements will help, but ultimately it is up to all of us to make the Wingate experience a positive one.
