- Applicants with a Ph.D. in Molecular Biology or a related field are encouraged to apply and all degree requirements should be completed by the start date.
- Preference will be given to those individuals demonstrating breadth and depth of experience and training in molecular biology as evidenced by their research and graduate transcripts.
- A strong commitment to undergraduate research is required and participation in undergraduate research is expected.

Priority will be given to applicants who submit materials by July 23<sup>rd</sup>, then selection will continue until the positions are filled.
