Position Title: Physician Assistant- Primary Care

Job Summary:

This is a full-time clinical position at Community Health Services of Union County, Inc. in conjunction with the Wingate University PA program. The PA will function independently in this adult primary care setting in collaboration with a supervising physician. Additionally, the PA may serve as a clinical preceptor for up to 10 Wingate University PA students annually and work collaboratively with Wingate Health Science Programs to develop Interprofessional education experiences for students. Clinic coverage will be Monday through Thursday with Friday remaining for charting and administrative duties. The PA may be required to participate in PA Program activities on occasional Fridays throughout the year.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

• Provide assessment, diagnosis, treatment, education, referral and follow-up for acute and chronic adult patient populations

- Perform women's wellness exams
- Perform minor surgical procedures (e.g. I&D, minor suturing)
- Order and interpret diagnostic testing
 - O Identify abnormal findings early and initiate appropriate intervention
- Ability to interact effectively with Wingate faculty and students
- Demonstrate initiative, problem solving ability, adaptability and flexibility
- Critically analyze data and evidence for improving clinical practice
- Actively participate to support team-level growth (e.g. sharing best practices, committee membership)
- Promote the mission of the Clinic, community awareness and partnership with Wingate University by participating in community based health fairs
- Proficient in use of computer and EMR
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills required in English. Bilingual/Spanish a plus

Physical Requirements
