Applicants with a Ph.D. in Molecular Biology or a related field are encouraged to apply, and all degree requirements should be completed by the start date. Preference will be given to those individuals demonstrating breadth and depth of experience and training in molecular biology as evidenced by their research and graduate transcripts.
