CEREMONY INFORMATION

The graduate commencement and hooding ceremony will take place in the Academic Quad on Friday, May 8, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

The undergraduate commencement ceremony will take place in the Academic Quad on Saturday, May 9, 2020 at 9 a.m.

TICKETS & SEATING

Please arrive early.

Tickets are not required. Seating is first-come, first-serve. Reserved seating for faculty, administrators, trustees, and graduating students are marked with ribbons. We do not designate an area for special needs guests because all seating in the Academic Quadrangle is accessible. The commencement ceremony seats are folding chairs, which can be easily moved to make room for a wheelchair, walker or stroller.

Shade is limited, so plan to arrive early to obtain seats in the shaded areas. A live feed is available in Austin Auditorium for overflow guests who prefer to sit indoors. A link to the live feed will also be available at https://youtu.be/JZHJa7_4Dc4

If the ceremony is moved to Cuddy Arena because of inclement weather, seating will be limited and tickets are required. Information on how tickets can be obtained will be emailed to graduates via their Wingate email addresses. Special needs guests with tickets will be seated in this section on a first come, first-serve basis.

PARKING

Parking for commencement is available in all campus parking lots. There is no cost to park when you're attending Commencement. You can expect to be directed by Campus Safety staff to an available lot. **Arrive early to get a better parking space.**

SPECIAL NEEDS PARKING

We are especially attentive to our guests who require a little extra help when traveling to Commencement. You or your guest must be attending Commencement and have a handicap parking permit to use handicapped parking for Commencement.

For those with handicap parking permits, enter the campus by taking a left onto North Main Street. Turn right onto Cedar Street. Turn left into the faculty parking lot. This lot is accessible to the Academic Quad. If you require additional assistance, please tell the parking lot attendant.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms will be available in Austin Auditorium, Burris, Hayes, Bridges and Smith Science buildings.

PHOTOGRAPHY

You may take pictures. Professional photographers are also present at Commencement to take pictures of graduates as they receive their diplomas. The photography studio will mail ordering information to graduates the week after Commencement. The ceremony is recorded as well. You may purchase DVDs through the Marketing and Communications Office for \$30 per DVD. Information for Graduates

FAQS

I am graduating. How do I find out about requirements, the Commencement ceremony and other important information?

First, you must apply for graduation. It's a graduation requirement. After you apply, the Office of the Registrar, Student Financial Planning, the Business Office and other campus offices will contact you sometime between the time you apply and graduation. We recommend that you visit the Commencement section on the website, (www.wingate.edu/around-campus/events/wingate-commencement), join your class social media pages and check for email from the Office of the Registrar after you apply so you stay up-to-date on the information you need.

When is the Commencement ceremony?

There will be two spring Commencement ceremonies—one for Graduate level candidates on Friday, May 8th at 6:30 p.m. on the Academic Quadrangle and the second for Undergraduate candidates on Saturday, May 9th at 9 a.m. also on the Academic Quadrangle. Degree candidates for both ceremonies will line up on Church St. between the Ethel K. Smith Library and Wingate Baptist Church 45 minutes before the ceremony start time—5:45 p.m. for Graduate candidates and 8:15 a.m. for Undergraduate candidates, respectively.

How do I purchase a cap and gown?

The easiest way is to visit the Herff-Jones website: colleges.herffjones.com/college/wingate

- Undergraduates need a bachelor's degree gown and cap.
- Graduate students receiving a MAED, MAT, MBA, MASM, MPAS or a MAC degree are required to have a master's gown, hood, and cap.
- Graduate students receiving an EdS degree need a doctoral gown, a master's hood, and cap.
- Students receiving a Doctor of Education, Doctor of Occupational Therapy, Doctor of Pharmacy or Doctor of Physical Therapy degree are required to have the doctoral gown, hood, tam, and tassel set.

The University reserves the right to remove a degree candidate from the Commencement ceremony if the candidate is not wearing the approved Wingate University regalia as shown on page 12 and 13. Questions regarding regalia should be emailed to Commencement@wingate.edu. Candidates are highly encouraged to use Herff Jones exclusively, as their website has correct information on approved WU regalia.

When is Commencement rehearsal? Do I have to attend?

Wingate does not have Commencement rehearsal. To watch a video about what you need to know for Commencement, please visit the Wingate YouTube site. Graduates will receive an email link to the video the week prior to the ceremonies.

What is the dress code?

Please review regalia specifications found on page 12. Caps and gowns are required. Stoles and fraternity cords are permitted. Honor cords are distributed prior to the Commencement lineup. "Sunday" dress is considered appropriate for both men and women. Ladies should wear dresses, skirts or dress trousers. Men should wear trousers and shirts with collars. Black shoes and socks are preferred. Guests should follow the same dress code. Women should exercise caution if wearing heels; not all walking will occur on pavement.

How are graduation honors calculated?

Undergraduate graduation honors are calculated using all college work attempted, but transfer work cannot raise the Wingate University GPA. Cumulative GPA is calculated by taking all quality points and dividing that by all hours attempted. GPAs are not rounded. As an example, if you have a 3.999, it will not be rounded to a 4.00.

Graduation honors are notated on your diploma, on your transcript and in the commencement program. Your honors are also announced during the commencement ceremony. Due to the limited amount of time between final grades and commencement, honors may not be completely accurate.

Graduation honors are as follows:

- Cum laude = 3.500 to 3.649
 (Doctors of Pharmacy and Physical Therapy: Cum laude = 3.50 to 3.69)
- Magna cum laude = 3.650 to 3.899
 (Doctors of Pharmacy and Physical Therapy: Magna cum laude = 3.70 to 3.89)
- Summa cum laude = 3.900 to 4.000
 (Doctors of Pharmacy and Physical Therapy: Summa cum laude = 3.90 to 4.00)

Please contact the Office of the Registrar if you have questions on how to calculate your GPA.

Where do I purchase my class ring?

You can purchase your class ring online from Herff Jones, the official graduation vendor of Wingate University. Their website makes it easy. You can purchase graduation announcements and diploma frames from Herff Jones as well. colleges.herffjones.com/college/wingate

If I do not participate in Commencement, when will I receive my diploma? If you choose not to participate in Commencement, your diploma will be mailed out by certified mail the week after Commencement. If you are an August graduate, your diploma will be sent by certified mail the week following the August conferral date. Please notify the Office of the Registrar that you do not plan to attend the ceremony.

I have completed my academic course requirements, but I have not completed my Lyceum Series. Will I be able to receive my diploma?

No. The Lyceum Series is a graduation requirement. You will not be eligible to walk in the Commencement ceremony, and your degree will not be awarded until the Lyceum requirement is fulfilled. The Lyceum Series only applies to undergraduate students (excluding those in the BLS program).

How long will seniors who live on campus have to check out of their oncampus housing?

Please contact the Office of Residence Life at 704-233-8245 for more information. Closer to Commencement, check-out procedures will be posted and distributed to all residential students. The deadline is Sunday at 5 p.m.



- Black robe with twin front pleats, long sleeves, and a zipper closure.
- The robe should fall around mid-shin length.
- Mortarboards (cap) with black tassels.
- Stoles (shown in left photo) are permitted to be worn.

- Black robe with elongated sleeve extensions draping below the wrist openings.
- The robe should fall around mid-shin to ankle length.
- Mortarboards (cap) with black tassels.
- Masters hood matching your degree:
 - Accounting Drab
 - Education Light Blue
 - Sport Management Sage Green
 - Teaching Light Blue
 - Business Administration Drab
 - Physician Assistant Studies Kelly Green

- Black Doctoral robe with bell sleeves and three chevrons on each sleeve in light blue, fine pleating velvet panels from the hemline to the center of the back, also in your discipline color.
- The robe should fall at ankle length.
- Masters of Education hood.
- Mortar board (cap) with light blue tassel.

Doctoral Regalia







- Black Doctoral robe with bell sleeves and three chevrons on each sleeve in your discipline color, fine pleating velvet panels from the hemline to the center of the back, also in your discipline colors.
- The robe should fall at ankle length.
- Doctoral hood (longer and wider than masters hoods).
- 8-pointed Tam (cap) with appropriate colored tassels

 - •Education Light Blue
 - •Physical Therapy Gold
